
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

Tools required to assembly the machine: Two Adjustable Wrenches Two Allen Wrenches

NOTE: It is strongly recommended that this machine be assembled by two or more people to avoid possible injury.


STEP 1 (SEE DIAGRAM 1)

- A.) Place the Lower Cross Brace (#3) on the floor. Attach a Base Frame (#2) to the Cross Brace and secure it with two M10x3 1/8" Bolts (#60), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), one 2 3/8"x5 1/8" Bracket (#4), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70).
- B.) Repeat the above procedure to install another Base Frame.
- C.) Attach an Upright Beam (#1) to the Base Frame (#2). Secure it with two M10x3 1/8" Bolts (#60), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70).
- D.) Repeat the above procedure C to install another Upright Beam on the other side.
- E.) Connect both Upright Beams (#1) on the top with an Upper Cross Brace (#11). Secure it with two M10x3 1/8" Bolts (#60), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), one 4 3/4"x2" Bracket (#19), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70) on each side of the Cross Brace.
- F.) Attach the Guide Rod Base (#5) to the Lower Cross Brace (#3) in the middle. Secure it with two M10x3 1/8" Bolts (#60), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70).
- G.) Slide the Glider (#6) onto the Chrome Guide Rod (#7). Attach the Chrome Guide Rod to the Guide Rod Base (#5). Secure it with two M10x2 1/2" Bolts (#58), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64) and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70).
- H.) Attach the Upper Frame (#10) to the top of the Chrome Guide Rod (#7) on the back and the Upper Cross Brace (#11) on the front. Secure the back with two M10x2 ½" Bolts (#58), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70). Secure the front with two M10x2 ¾" Bolts (#59), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70).
- I.) Attach four Left and Right Bar Catches (#15 & #16) to the Upright Beams (#1).
- J.) Attach a Storage Post (#14) to the Upright Beam (#1). Secure it with a Ø7/8" Washer (#64) and M10x1" Bolt (#55) on the back. Slide a Rubber Bumper (#35) onto the Post. Repeat the procedure to install another Post onto the other Upright Beam.




STEP 2 (SEE DIAGRAM 2)

- A.) Attach the 128" Upper Cable (#18) to the front of the Upper Frame (#10). Attach Pulley (#68) and two Pulley Covers (#69) to the Cable. Align the holes on the Pulley to the Upper Frame and secure it with one M10x2 ½" Bolt (#58), two Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#70).
- B.) Draw the Cable towards the back of the machine. Install another Pulley Set to the opening on the Upper Frame (#10). Draw the Cable downward through the Upper Frame.
- C.) Install another Pulley Set with two Double Floating Brackets (#13). Secure the Bracket with one M10x1 ¾" Bolt (#56), two Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#70). Let the Bracket hanging for now.
- D.) Draw the Cable upward through the opening to the top the Chrome Guide Rod. Install another Pulley Set.
- E.) Draw the Cable over the Pulley Set and downward towards the Glider (#6). Connect the Cable to the Hook Bolt (#20).
- F.) Insert the Chrome Weight Post (#8) halfway through the Glider (#6). Insert the Hook Bolt (#20) into the Glider and secure it with two Ø7/8* Washers (#64) and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#70).
- G.) Attach the 109" Lower Cable (#17) to the bracket on the Guide Rod Base (#5). Install a Pulley Set and secure it with one M10x1 3/4" Bolt (#56), two Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#70).
- H.) Draw the Cable upward towards the hanging Double Floating Brackets (#13) previously installed in procedure C above. Install a Pulley Set. Draw the Cable over the Pulley and downward towards the Guide Rod Base (#5). Secure the Cable to the Base with one M10x1" Bolt (#55), two Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#70).
- I.) Attach the Curl Bar (#9) to the beginning of the Cable with two Clips (#52) and one Chain (#67).



STEP 3 (SEE DIAGRAM 3)

- A.) Attach the Front Leg (#24) to the Front Stabilizer (#28). Secure it with three Ø7/8" Washers (#64) and M10 x 5/8" Bolts (#54).
- B.) Slide the Sliding Block (#30) onto the Main Seat Support (#23). Attach the Main Seat Support to the Front Leg (#24). Secure it with two M10x1" Bolts (#55), four Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and two M10 Aircraft Nuts (#70).
- C.) Attach the Rear Stabilizer (#27) to the back of the Main Seat Support (#23). Secure it with two Ø7/8" Washers (#64) and M10 x 5/8" Bolts (#54).
- D.) Attach the Seat (#37) onto the brackets on the Main Seat Support (#23). Align the holes and install four Ø1/2" Washers (#66) and M6 x 1 3/8" Bolts (#62).
- E.) Attach the Backrest Adjustment Bar (#31) to the Sliding Block (#30) and secure it with one M10 x 2 7/8" Bolt (#57), two Ø7/8" Washers (#64), and one M10 Aircraft Nut (#70).
- F.) Insert the Backrest Pivot Rod (#32) into the front opening on the Backrest Adjustment Bar (#31). Attach one Backrest Support (#29) to the Pivot welded on the Main Seat Support (#23). Raise up the Backrest Support (#29) to align the hole with the Backrest Pivot Rod (#32). Push the Rod into the hole on the Support. Install another Backrest Support on the other side.
- G.) Place the Backrest Board (#38) onto the Backrest Supports (#29). Align the four holes and secure it with four Ø1/2" Washers (#66) and M6 x 1 3/8" Bolts (#62).
- H.) Insert the Arm Curl Stand (#22) into the opening on the Front Leg (#24). Secure the Stand with a Pull Pin (#53).
- I.) Attach the Arm Curl Pad (#36) to the top of the Arm Curl Stand (#22) and secure it with two Ø3/4" Washers (#65) and M8 x 5/8" Bolts (#61).



STEP 4 (See Diagram 4)


A.) Release the Pull Pin and pull the Arm Curl out from the Front Leg.


B.) Insert the Leg Developer Holder (#25) into the opening. Attach the Leg Developer (#26) to the bracket on the Holder. Secure it with one Axle (#49), two Ø3/4" Washers (#65), and two M8x5/8" Allen Bolts (#71).

C.) Insert three Foam Roll Tubes (#33) haifway through the holes on the Leg Developer (#26) and its Holder (#25). Push six Foam Rolls (#50) onto the Tubes from both


sides. Plug six End Caps (#46) to the end of the Tubes.

D.) Slide the Weight Post (#34) halfway through the Leg Developer (#26). Push two Rubber Bumpers (#35) onto the Post. Attach two Ø1" Spring Clips (#51) to the Post.
