




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

NOTE: It is strongly recommended two or more people assembling this machine to avoid possible injury.

STEP 1 (See Diagram1)


- A.) Attach the Rear Stabilizer (#3) to the Main Frame (#1). Secure it with two M10 x 3" Carriage Bolts (#15), Ø1" Bent Washers (#16), and M10 Acorn Nuts (#17).
- B.) Attach the Front Stabilizer (#2) to the Main Frame. Secure it with two M10 x 2 3/8" Carriage Bolts (#31), Ø1" Bent Washers (#16), and M10 Acorn Nuts (#17).
- C.) Plug the Roller Caps (#28) onto both ends of Front Stabilizer (#2). Plug the Rear Stabilizer End Caps (#29) onto both ends of Rear Stabilizer (#3). Set the bike firmly on a flat surface. If the surface is uneven, rotate the Rear Stabilizer End Caps to level the bike.

STEP 2 (See Diagram 2)


- A.) Note: In able to hold the Handlebar Post (#4) while connecting the cables and wires, extra help may be needed.
- B.) Attach the Handlebar Post (#4) to the Main Frame (#1). Connect the Middle Computer Sensor Wire (#21) from the bottom of Handlebar Post to the Lower Computer Sensor Wire (#22) from the main body of the bike.
- C.) Slide the cable wire from the Upper Tension Connector (#20) in between the opening on the wire holder on the Lower Tension Connector (#23). Pull the Upper Tension Connector upward and slide the wire through the slot on the bracket.
- D.) Drop down the Connector so the fitting sits firmly on top of the bracket.
- E.) Secure the Handlebar Post (#4) to the Main Frame (#1) with three M8 x 5/8" Allen Bolts (#18) and Ø 7/8" Bent Washers (#19).
- F.) Connect Middle Computer Sensor Wire (#21) to Upper Computer Sensor Wire (#24).
- G.) Slide the Computer (#6) onto the plate on the Handlebar Post.



STEP 3 (See Diagram 3)

- A.) Attach the Seat (#8) to the Seat Post (#7). Secure it with three Ø 5/8" Washers (#12), Spring Washers (#13), and M8 Aircraft Nuts (#14).
- B.) Insert the Seat Post into the opening on the Main Frame (#1). Use a Seat Post Lock Knob (#11) to secure the Seat Post at desired height.
- C.) Attach the Handle Bar (#5) to the Handlebar Post (#4). Secure it with a Bracket (#30), M8 x ¾" Allen Bolt (#27), and a T-shaped Knob (#26). Use the Knob to adjust the position of the Handlebar.




STEP 4 (See Diagram 4)

A.) Thread the Left Pedal (#9) counterclockwise into the left Crank (#25). Thread the Right Pedal (#10) Clockwise into the Crank on the other side.

COMPUTER



AUTO START / STOP

REPLACE BATTERY:
